 - Indoor ratio 1 adult to 6 members, plus the leader in charge
 - Outdoor ratio 1 adult to 4 members, plus the leader in charge

- Beavers

- POR Recommended Maximum Size 24
- Indoor ratio minimum of 2 adults present
- Outdoor ratio 1 adult to 6 members, plus the leader in charge

- Cubs

- POR Recommended Maximum Size 36
- Indoor ratio minimum of 2 adults present
- Outdoor ratio 1 adult to 8 members, plus the leader in charge

- Scouts

- POR Recommended Maximum Size No recommended maximum
- Indoor ratio minimum of 2 adults present
- Outdoor ratio 1 adult to 12 members

- Explorers

- POR Recommended Maximum Size No recommended maximum
- Indoor ratio minimum of 2 adults present
- Outdoor ratio minimum of 2 adults present

- Introducing Our Volunteer Culture
 - What is it: Our Volunteering Culture is a shared set of principles that outline how we behave, in line with our values.

- Transition to Trustee Boards

- What is it: We are renaming Executive Committees and Executive Committee Members as Trustee Boards and Trustees respectively. Trustee Boards will focus on governance activities. Support activities (such as fundraising, premises management or administration) currently led by Executive Committees will move to other teams in the Group/District.

- What can we do now: Adopt the title of Trustee Boards; Adoption of the new constitution; Prepare for changes of responsibility
